Subject: Reduction in the age of superannuation from 62 years to 60 years of blind Government employees.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the instructions of the State Government issued vide No. 34/10/95-4GS1, dated 29.08.2014, in which the age of superannuation of blind Government employees was increased from 60 years to 62 years.

2. The matter has been reconsidered by the State Government and it has now been decided that the age of superannuation (retirement) for blind employees be reduced from 62 years to 60 years with immediate effect.

3. It is further decided that the employees who had reached superannuation age, but could not be retired till date due to enhanced superannuation age as per instructions dated 29.8.2014 will now be retired/superannuated on 30.11.2014. This decision may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
