The petitioner seeks a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to grant 5% relaxation/concession in qualifying marks in the Haryana Teachers Eligibility Test-2011 to the disabled persons i.e., by reducing the qualifying marks from 60% to 55% at par with the Scheduled Castes Category candidates. In this regard, the petitioner is said to have made a representation dated 10.12.2011 (Annexure P-10) but without any response thereto. The petitioner has relied upon a decision of this Court dated 4.11.2011 rendered in <u>CWP No.20517 of 2011 (Kiran and others versus</u> <u>State of Haryana and others)</u> (Annexure P-7) for consideration of his claim sympathetically.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the considered view that the afore-mentioned representation of the petitioner

requires sympathetic consideration by the respondent-authorities. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the respondentauthorities to consider the claim of the petitioner in the light of the observations made in the order dated 4.11.2011 passed in <u>Kiran and others'</u> <u>case (supra)</u>, within a period of <u>two weeks</u> from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
