REGARDING CASTE-CENSUS DUTY BEING PERFORMED BY SUBJECT:-TEACHERS.

Reference on the subject cited above.

It has been observed by the department that a very large number of school lecturers have been assigned the caste-census duty as the teachers teaching elementary classes are exempted under RTE Act. This has seriously impaired teaching of secondary and senior secondary classes. As students in class X & XII have to prepare for Board examination, absence of their teachers from class-rooms has adversely affected their education. All the Heads of Institutions (Principals/Headmasters) are required to ensure that teachers on such duty must not be spared during teaching hours. This duty should be performed after teaching hours. The Heads of Institutions (Principals/Headmasters) may be directed to ensure the compliance of these instructions and relieve teachers for census duty accordingly.

Any laxity in this regard shall be viewed seriously.
